



Completion Definitions

Primary Completions - The unduplicated count of students earning credentials in a given rollup program. Each student is counted once, at the highest degree level credential the student earned (AS>AAS>TC>CT). Ties are decided by an alphabetical sort of major code. Please note the de-duplication occurs at the rollup program level. Students earning credentials from more than one rollup program are counted once in each rollup program that they earned a credential in. Primary completers represent the overall supply for the rollup program.

Secondary Completions - Any additional credentials from the rollup program awarded to students counted in Primary Completions. These are not used in the overall supply for the rollup program and are displayed for informational purposes only. The sum of Primary Completions and Secondary Completions equals the total number of completions for the rollup program.

Annualized Term Code - The term code of the awarded degree.

100% completion metric - This metric captures program completion rate at 100% time and represents the percentage of students in a defined cohort completing the program within 100% of time. 100% of time is defined as two terms for a CT; three terms for a TC; and six terms for an Associate.

150% completion metric - This metric captures program completion rate at 150% time and represents the percentage of students in a defined cohort completing the program within 150% of time. 150% of time is defined as three terms for a CT; four terms for a TC; and nine terms for an Associate.

300% completion metric - This metric captures program completion rate at 300% time and represents the percentage of students in a defined cohort completing the program within 300% time. 300% of time is defined as six terms for a CT; nine terms for a TC; and 18 terms for an Associate.
